













Sustainable Sporting Events

What:

Sustainability means using our resources efficiently. People today should not be living at the expense of people in other regions of the world and of future generations.

Why:

Sustainability affects all areas of our lives and economies and is thus a task for the whole of society. It requires societal development that is ecologically viable, socially fair and economically efficient. Sustainability must have a positive "lasting" value.



• Consider venues that are easily accessible by public transportation

1. Venue

- Prioritize renewable energy resources, such as water conservation
- (i.e. low-flow toilets and sinks) • Partner with venues that offer the option to offset the carbon
- emissions produced by events (i.e. by planting trees)

• Encourage the use of public transport and clean vehicles (i.e. bicycles, electric cars) and offer a discount to people who can prove that they came using one of these

2. Transportation

- methods • To reduce transport-related emissions, use easily accessible venues where green transport is available





· Choose accommodation options that have been certified as eco-friendly and offer special discounts for event participants and spectators

3. Accommodation

- Choose accommodation easily accessible by foot, bicycle, or public transportation
- Choose and recommend accommodation accessible for people with a disability


• Ensure that there is a waste management concept for sorting and recycling waste

• Offer tap water to drink

4. Catering

- Serve all food in reusable or compostable dishes, avoiding single-use plastic and disposable items
- Offer regional, seasonal, organic food and beverages
- Plan to distribute and donate leftovers to a food bank

• Avoid unnecessary food waste and costs

5. Recycling

• Provide prominent recycling options for visitors

• Reuse and/or recycle goods and supplies used during the event

- Support local businesses and second-hand supplies by hiring, sharing

Ensure staff have received anti-discrimination and inclusion training
